

Thought Essay on Medieval Egyptian Jews

Sources for Your Paper

For this assignment, please use the text *Heresy and the Politics of Community* by Marina Rustow. Remember to cite all sources properly.

Paper Content

Please respond to this deceptively straightforward prompt:

Marina Rustow's text explores the political, religious, economic, and social relationship between the Rabbanite and Qaraite Jews of medieval Egypt. Overall, the evidence she presents suggests that these two distinctive Jewish sectarian communities were incredibly distinct from each other – in fact – ***it can be argued that the only relationship they shared was their common belief in Judaism.*** Please state why or why not you agree with this statement and support your position with multiple (at least three) specific cases derived from the book. In your essay, be sure to discuss what distinguished these two sects of Judaism as well any commonalities. Where possible, indicate how Christians and Muslims interacted with these communities and if this has any bearing on how these Jewish sects related to each other. That is, did one Jewish sect have closer relations with Christians or Muslims and did this exacerbate tensions between the two Jewish communities?

Preparing and Formatting of Your Essay

- Your essay should be four to five pages long. (Longer papers are acceptable.)
- You should argue a position in your essay, i.e., use a thesis statement.
- Use 11 or 12 point font, 1 inch margins, double-spacing, and page numbering.
- Use a topic sentence to start each paragraph, so that the reader knows what you intend on arguing within it.
- Use a proper introduction, body (several paragraphs), and a brief conclusion in your paper. Indent the start of each paragraph.
- You should use and/or quote specific examples from the reading to support your thoughts. Use *The Chicago Manual of Style* to footnote your sources. See Dr. Martinez's Writing Resources for Students at <http://bit.ly/16tj9SV>. Please use a Works Cited/Bibliography page, especially if you are referencing other material not being used in this class.
- Please staple your paper together and attach a copy of the grading rubric to the back of your paper.
